

New Event, New Club Record for Janet!

9 SNHAC athletes were in action at the British University Championships in Sheffield over the **weekend**

Performance of the event came from Janet Browne. Having specialised in high jump as an athlete for 10 years she took part in her first triple jump competition at a varsity match in January where an 11m57 leap saw her selected for the Brunel University team in Sheffield. 11m73 in her pool saw her qualify for the final where a jump of 11m86 saw her placed sixth and break the Club Record which has stood since 2002.

Also competing Nathan Gardner (Cardiff University) came 4th in the pole vault with 4m70 clearance and Max Schoop (Brunel University) ran a personal best of 49.66 in the semi-final of the 400m.

Unluckiest athlete was Jack Gladman who was 'taken out' in his last lap of the 1500m where he was hoping to run a personal best. Other Club athletes in action were Lauren Rule 200m (Kent), Rebecca Beddall 400m (Southampton), James Beddall 800m (Northampton), William Cartledge HJ (Bath) and Martha Huggins PV (Durham).
